- How we introduce a book. We know we need to tell you the title, what the book is mostly about and maybe an interesting fact from the book to get you interested before we read.
- Some new sight words! This week's words are: **and** and **like**
- Writing about things we know. We have had fun writing about our stuffed animals and action figures! We draw detailed pictures, add labels and we've been working so hard to write sentences about them. We know that using the sight words we know can help us write more.
- How to use an alphabet chart. We know that some letters are near the beginning of the alphabet and some are near the end. This helps us to find letters quickly when we're writing. We even did an alphabet chart puzzle and had to find the right place for missing letters.
- Problem solving. We've been trying out some "3 Act Tasks". Here, we see a short clip or photo, think about what we notice and what we wonder, then see if we have enough information to solve our problem.
- We are learning that you can solve problems in lots of different ways. We've used cubes, drawings and our fingers to solve addition and subtraction problems.
- The weather. We are noticing that the temperature continues to drop week after week as we get further into fall. We're graphing the temperature, too!
