




Ask Me About



Week of 12/11

- Using our Super Sound Power to read unknown words. We are learning to look at the first letter and tap it's sound, then move to the second letter and tap it's sound, then blend the two sounds together. Then we keep going until we read to the end of the word.



- Digraphs! (Don't expect me to remember that word!) We are learning that some letters pair up with others and make their own special sound. We've learned sh-, ch-, and th-.
- Sight words. We are really relying on our sight word power so keep practicing! We've learned: I, a, and, am, is, in, it, go, here, she, he, me, my, said, to, the, like and we.
- How I make my writing more readable. We continue to work on using upper and lower case letters, spaces and punctuation.
- How I can hear more sounds in words when I write. I am using my tapping skills when writing too! I can tap a word I'm trying to write, then write one sound at a time.
- Numbers to 10. We have been practicing all the ways these numbers can look (numeral, tallies, ten frames and dots). We've also been finding all the different ways to compose these numbers (4 + 3, 5 + 2, 6 + 1, and 7 + 0 all equal 7)
- Our science experiment!! We're looking to see how important water and sun are for plants. We have a plant that gets water and one that doesn't and a plant that gets sun and one that doesn't. We've seen the effects already!
