



Ask Me About

- How I use the clues in the pictures and what I know about a topic to find words in a book! “I found “snake” because I saw a picture of a snake and knew it started with /s/!”
- How I sit back to back with my partner for independent reading, then knee to knee to read as partners.
- What a label is. How does it help tell about the picture. Ask me how I learned to label my pictures! I say the word for what’s in my picture, listen to the sounds, then write down what I hear, one sound at a time.
- How to write the letters t, b and f. I start at the “skyline” for each of these letters, then draw to the “grass line”. These are the lines on my paper. I can show you on the back of this paper!



- To tell you about position words. What’s the difference between next to and in front of? How about over and under?
- How I compared the weight of objects using a pan balance.
- “Our Tree”! We made a sketch of a tree that we will continue to observe throughout the year to see how the weather affects it.
