

Ask Me About

Week of 9/24

*How I notice patterns in my old favorite story books.

*How I use connecting words like, “and then...”, “after that...”, “suddenly...” and “finally...” to retell my old favorites.

*How I get ideas for writing by telling stories. I remember to tell what happened first, next, after that and last. Then I can write the story I tell!



*All the letters we’ve learned so far! We’ve learned the letter name, sound and proper formation for the letters t,b,f,m,n,l and u. Ask me to tell you the “letter sound card” for each letter. (t, top, /t/, b, bat, /b/, f, fun,/f/, m, man, /m/, n, nut, /n/, l, itch, /i/, u, up, /u/)

*Our first sight words: I, and a. Try finding them in the books we read.

*Our sight word song is in my home-school folder. I can sing it for you! Be on the look out for new words next week.

*Rekenrecks! We learned to use these fun tools to help us break apart numbers. Ask me to tell you different ways to make the number 5.



*How I keep track of objects that I count when they are in a circle or scattered. (I can mark where I start, line them up or move them as I count so I don’t count any twice!)
