- ★ We ARE readers! We learned that we can already read a lot of words. We took a tour of the building and read words everywhere, like “Exit” and “Nurse’s Office” and “Library”.
- ★ We can look, think and read the pictures in books!
- ★ We can read on our own and with a partner. Check out our website to see pictures of how we read with our partners!

- ★ We are writers too! We can picture what we want to write about and draw that on the page.
- ★ Some kids were already beginning to write the sounds of the words they want to write!

- ★ In math, we practiced counting and matching numbers to quantities. We played a game with our friends with “dot cards”. It’s a lot like “War”. Whoever has the most dots, gets to take both cards.
- ★ We also practiced position words like over, around, between, under and behind. Check out pictures of our obstacle course on our webpage! We had to go **across** the bumpy rocks, **between** the chairs, **under** the table, **behind** the red chair and **over** the pillows.

- ★ We started learning about writing letters using the lines on the paper. We learned that some letters are tall, some are small and some hang below the line.

- ★ We practiced our first fire drill and lockdown this week. The kids did a great job following the rules and understanding that this was practice and there was no emergency.

- ★ We got to celebrate Colin’s birthday on Friday! Happy birthday, Colin!
